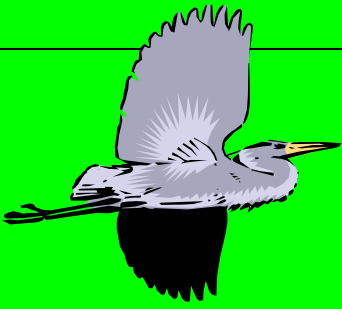
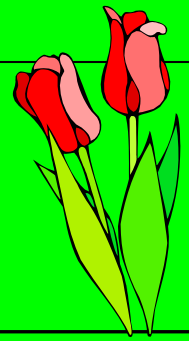

### **BHP HOA Annual Homeowner's Meeting, May 5, 7:00 PM.**

The annual homeowner's meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 5th, at 7:00 PM at the BHP Golf Course Clubhouse. All homeowners are urged to attend this important meeting.



### **Changes to Galloway Township Leaf and Yard Waste Pick-up:**

Your tax dollars not at work! Due to the reduced funding provided by our NJ government, Galloway Township is cutting some essential services. Galloway Township will no longer pick up leaves - you must drop off at the recycle center on Galloway Road (accepting leaves & grass only). Another impact of the budget cuts is that the Galloway recycle center will no longer accept yard waste such as brush, shrub clippings, tree branches, etc. To dispose of this type of yard waste, residents must go to the ACUA on Delilah Road in EHT. There is a \$26 charge per ton. Since most BHP residents do not have the proper vehicle to transport such items, residents may call Outdoor Décor (856-435-2425) or Evergreen (609-652-0646) to either perform complete yard clean-up services and removal, or if you prefer to do your own yard work, they can be hired to dispose of your yard waste. Both agencies would prefer that neighbors coordinate a collective pick-up date.

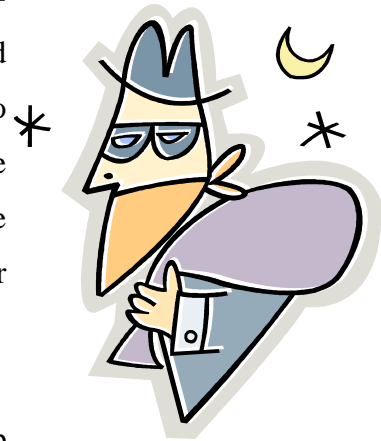

### **BHP Neighborhood Watch - Message from John DeMarco -**

Spring is here! Nice weather, open garages, open vehicles in driveways, friends/family come over leaving cars unlocked, and crime picks up. On 4/16 we had an incident on 503 Country Club Drive reported by Block Captain Gene McCann. A resident left their vehicle unlocked and personal belongings were taken out of the car and dumped on the lawn. The Police were called and the incident reported. Norma Meyer, from Dilucia management also called reporting several similar incidents in "The Woods" where vehicles were left unlocked and items were taken. Galloway police and Hamilton police are involved. Two juvenile's were arrested by Hamilton police in a stolen car which traced a stolen cell phone to a resident in the Woods.



The Neighborhood Watch team will run some patrols in May and June to keep the bad guys honest, but in the interim please keep watch in the community and inform your neighbors. Report anything to the police. Its important that we do not become complacent. A reminder to all our BHP residents from the Neighborhood Watch Team is to keep doors locked in all vehicles left in the driveway and to close garage doors.

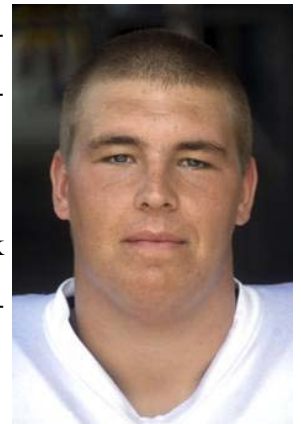

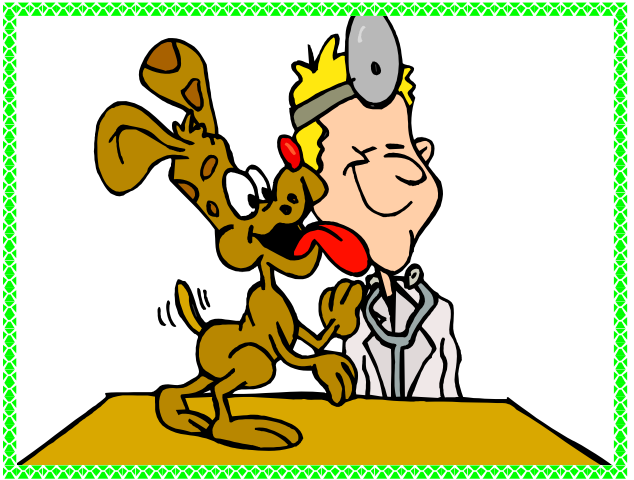

The theme is: **A Tasting of Italian Wines**

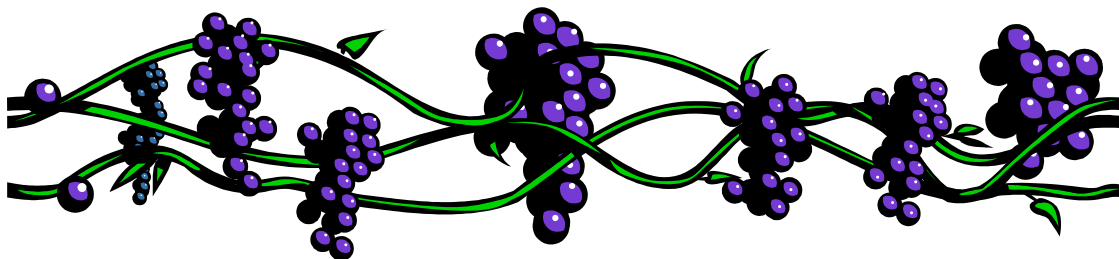

Single White Aluminum Post: \$250  
Double White Aluminum Post: \$375  
Installation of new post and removal of old post: \$85  
New Aluminum Mailbox with Numbers: \$90  
Aluminum Newspaper Box: \$50  
Newspaper Box Installation only: \$35  
All prices subject to sales tax!
