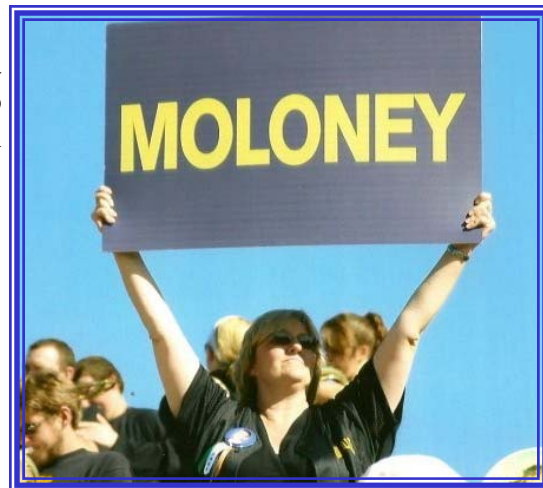

BHP Wine Tasting Event Results - (article provided by Maurice Shepherd) The Blue Heron Pines Homeowner's Association wine tasters gathered at our clubhouse on Saturday October 17, 2009, for a tasting of southern New Jersey wines. This fifteenth HOA wine tasting was attended by 35 people who tasted four white wines and four red wines and had a great time doing it.

All of the wines were tasted and purchased in advance by the hosts at multiple southern New Jersey wineries.

The average rating results on a 1 to 20 scale from the attendees are as follows:

- Turis winery in Cape May Chardonnay opener – not rated - \$16.05
- Bellview winery in Landisville Pinot Grigio rated 11.9 - \$12.83
- Bellview Traminette rated 11.6 - \$12.83
- Plagido's winery in Hammonton Choice Signature White Wine rated 13.7 - \$18.18
- Renault winery in Egg Harbor City/ Galloway Sauvignon Blanc rated 8.5 - \$16.04
- Tomasello winery in Hammonton Shiraz rated 14.3 - \$17.17
- Balic winery in Mays Landing American Red Velvet rated 13.5 - \$14.93
- Heritage winery in Richwood Steel Rails Red rated 15.1 - \$13.90
- Turis winery in Cape May Cabernet Sauvignon rated 14.2 - \$21.40
